<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Please check the 2 days of activities folder on the class pages After 2 days, set learning matched to the learning missed in the classroom. Upload to class pages on website with the appropriate dates. Provide clear forms of instruction to allow the child to complete the learning Assess learning that has been submitted within the school day – children can send this information to class email addresses Provide paper copies if a device is not available or it is requested. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Plan for the majority of lessons that would usually happen in the school day. <i>For example, for more practically based lessons, such as P.E., there would be an expectation that the children participate in some form of exercise that day.</i> Ensure learning matches the curriculum needs of the pupils. Provide a suitable form of instruction, modelling or scaffolding for each lesson. If deemed the most effective form of delivery, a recorded session will be arranged and be uploaded or emailed via class email Supplement lessons with activities, workbooks, textbooks, videos, good quality online resources and other suitable materials to ensure children are continuing their planned learning. <i>E.g. Oak Academy / pre-recorded phonics videos/ YouTube videos.</i> Assess learning either individually, as a group or whole class level and use this to inform what learning happens next. Ensure there is continued access to appropriate level of texts. Contact parents if required to discuss learning. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Commit to completing if possible all learning set by the class teacher DAILY or by the timescale given. Submit learning for assessment via class emails. This could be a photo, file, online form or quiz. Listen or read carefully to instructions/ explanations given or watch a given video. Ask questions, if unsure how to complete learning. Send a message via class emails. Continue to read regularly as well as complete Numbots/TTRs as per our Home Learning policy. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Have notified the school of their accessibility to a device. So the best provision can be put into place. Have checked they can access and find relevant information on schools website Ensure their device is secure and they are following school protocols for using the online platforms Know where to access learning. Website – class pages Classes Luddenham School Check their child completes the expected learning set or communicate timely the reason it has not. Keep communication open with school so we can always provide the support needed. Know where and when to submit learning completed and support in this process if needed.
