Dear Parents/Carers,

We are writing to you to confirm the details of our exciting trip to Wembley on Thursday 13th November. We would like the children to attend school for the day in non-uniform, so that the children don't have unnecessary extra baggage with them for the trip.

We are hoping to leave school at 2:30 p.m. and travel up to Wembley, arriving around 5 – 5.30 p.m, depending on traffic. We hope to then walk around the stadium before taking our seats later on ready for kick off at 7.45 p.m. It is difficult to say an exact time that we expect to be back, but we will text you all when we leave Wembley and when we are about 30 minutes from being back. We expect it to be quite late though, around midnight/ 1a.m. We are asking you to collect at the car park/road opposite the Premier Inn, by Aldi, Tettenhall Wy, ME13 8ZA, as this is well lit and will have plenty of space at that time of night.

It is important that the children can bring in some extra warm and waterproof clothes that day, as we will stand outside at Wembley for quite a few hours. This should include woolly hats, thick coat and gloves. Children will also be required to pack a substantial packed tea (in a disposable bag), to eat on the minibus on the way up. No fizzy drinks or glass bottles please. Mobile phones and other electrical devices are strictly forbidden; staff will be taking photos of the trip and sharing them with you via the school website.

There will be an opportunity for the children to buy souvenirs, however since Wembley is cashless, we will use our school debit card to purchase any souvenirs for the children, up to £10. This is of course optional. Please await further information regarding this.

The cost of the trip is **£35**, which is a voluntary contribution. Please make payment before the trip date. Payments can be made via Gateway.

If your child requires medication e.g. travel sickness pills, can this please be brought into the school office and we will take this with us on the day, along with any other medication e.g. asthma pumps that are usually kept in school.

We are all very much looking forward to this trip and we hope that the children have a great time. We will be speaking with them about expectations of maintaining good levels of behaviour to ensure all parties are kept safe, so if you can please reiterate this with your own children, it would be much appreciated. It will be extremely busy and it is vital that the children stick with their adults at all times. The adults attending will be Mr McLanaghan, Mr Crabb, Mr Wickham and Miss Culver.
