Year R - Term 4 Forest School Sessions starting Wednesday 25th February – 1st April 2026

Your child has been selected to take part in our on-site Forest School next term for six morning or afternoon session. Forest School is different to classroom-based learning and an alternative that we are proud to offer our children. This year we have Anna Outdoors leading forest school. The many benefits to Forest School are that your child will have the opportunity to explore the natural environment, lead their own play and learning, manage risk and build resilience, independence and social skills.

It is very important that your child has, the appropriate clothing and footwear for Forest School. Please see the clothing list below. Your child should arrive at school on Wednesday in their Forest School clothes with a change of clothes. We will provide your child with waterproof trousers and a coat (these can be, worn over or under their usual coat in winter as an additional layer). It is a good idea for your child to have additional layers, even in good weather, just in case.

Clothing list:

- Wellies.
- Long sleeved top (including in summer to protect from stings and bites).
- Trousers or leggings.
- A bag that your child can put muddy wellies in after the session.

In hot weather

- A sun hat.
- Sun cream. For your child to apply by themselves.
- Mosquito spray. For your child to apply by themselves.

In cold weather

- Hat and gloves
- Extra socks
- Thick jumper
- Extra layers
