Learning Overview

This term we will be reading: - The Stone Age Boy - Satoshi Kitamura - Ug - Raymond Briggs Our Novel Study lessons will be based on these books and in English we will be using them as inspiration to write portal narratives and newspaper reports.	At the beginning of term we will recap spelling rules learnt at the end of Year 2, such as the suffixes -ed and -ing and apostrophes for contraction. We will then learn about words with the 'ai' sound spelt in different ways like in 'eight' and 'straight'. We will finish the term by learning about homophones.	To begin the year we will be learning about place value, looking specifically at partitioning, recapping our knowledge of hundreds, tens and ones, then moving on to compare and order 4 digit numbers. Then we will move onto addition and subtraction, adding and subtracting across tens and hundreds.	Our History topic is 'Would you have preferred to live in the Stone Age, Bronze Age or Iron Age?'. We will be learning about Skara Brae, the impact of trade on this time period and the differences between the different ages. Our Science topic is 'Animals: Movement and Nutrition' and in French we will learn some greetings.
